Department of Agriculture. IFCA and IDA prepare the
content of the course and instructors cover topics and
issues related to NH₃ safety.

Anhydrous ammonia is an extremely hazardous
material. Experience in Illinois has shown that NH₃
can be handled and used safely. IFCA's annual NH₃
safety schools have contributed to this good safety
record for over 35 years.

**Don't assume you or your employees
remember NH₃ safety. Attend the school!**

State and Federal Law.**

In addition to this training course complying
with Illinois Department of Agriculture
(IDA), USEPA and Federal Rail
Administration regulations, participants who
attend and satisfactorily meet anhydrous
ammonia test requirements will receive a
Certificate of Training and qualify under
Illinois and Federal regulations as a
“Competent Attendant”.

The IDA will issue training certificates to all
persons who successfully pass the exam.
Certificates will be mailed to you.
