through the combined efforts of IFCA and the Illinois  
Department of Agriculture. IFCA and IDA prepare the  
content of the course and instructors cover topics and  
issues related to NH<sub>3</sub> safety.

Anhydrous ammonia is an extremely hazardous  
material. Experience in Illinois has shown that NH<sub>3</sub>  
can be handled and used safely. IFCA's annual NH<sub>3</sub>  
safety schools have contributed to this good safety  
record for over 35 years.

**Don't assume you or your employees  
remember NH<sub>3</sub> safety. Attend the school!**

**\*Training is mandatory once every three years by  
State and Federal Law.**
