

IFCA'S Fall 2020 Online Anhydrous Ammonia Training Starts September 01, 2020

DESIGNED FOR RETAIL AND FARMER OWNED ANHYDROUS AMMONIA OPERATORS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES TO:

- ... train employees who handle and transport NH₃
 - a review for experienced employees
 - yet basic enough for new employees.
- ... provide managers an annual review of regulations and safe operations.
- ... meet government regulation training standards, and document employee training.
- ... avoid accidents and escalating insurance costs and minimize liability.

State of Illinois regulations (Illinois Admin Code Title 8, Chapter I, Part 215, Subpart A) requires that any person at a commercial or non-commercial site who makes or breaks a connection on anhydrous ammonia equipment pertaining to the load & unloading as defined in the rule, or who maintains or repairs anhydrous ammonia vessels or associated equipment shall be a certified competent attendant.

THE 2020 NH₃ SAFETY SCHOOLS are offered through the combined efforts of IFCA and the Illinois Department of Agriculture. IFCA and IDA prepare the content of the course and cover topics and issues related to NH₃ safety.

Anhydrous ammonia is an extremely hazardous material. Experience in Illinois has shown that NH₃ can be handled and used safely. IFCA's annual NH₃ safety schools have contributed to this good safety record for over 35 years.

***Training is mandatory once every three years by State and Federal Law.**

Due to restrictions on in-person NH₃ training this fall, the Illinois Department of Agriculture is allowing online training in order for those individuals to certify as a competent attendant.

This training will meet the requirements for both first time individuals and those individuals needing to re-certify as a competent attendant.

After completion of the on-line training and quiz, you will be able to print out a certificate of completion.

THE TRAINING CERTIFICATE IS ONLY VALID THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020
